Frequently asked questions

What is the P&C?

The P&C is an incorporated not for profit organisation run by volunteers that is highly involved in the activities of the school.

What does the P&C do?

Key functions of the P&C are operating the **tuckshop**, **uniform shop**, **Outside Hours Care** and **fundraising** to ensure the school can provide the best possible learning environment for our children. Interactive whiteboards and the purchase of air-conditioning units for all the classrooms have been recent priorities.

As a parent am I automatically a member?

No, being a parent doesn't give you automatic membership. You need to attend a general meeting and complete a membership form. P&C membership is open to parents and guardians of pupils attending the school and to all citizens within the school community.

What are the advantages of membership?

Having a vote in decisions about your school.

The P&C needs **LOTS** of members so that the interests of our broad community can be considered. Decisions that the P&C vote on can affect people in different ways, it would be ideal if everyone in our school community had a voice.
